

Day 1: (D) CANBERRA TO TUMUT: Easter Saturday 20 April

Welcome aboard Potter Travel's 3 day tour to the Snowies, featuring the Adaminaby Fair. Cooma will be our first stop to enjoy morning tea before climbing further into the Snowy Mountains to our destination of Adaminaby. Day 2: (BLD) EXPLORING TUMUT: Easter Sunday 21 April

Tumut is the most northern town in the Snowy Scheme and sits on the Tumut River in fertile countryside. Its picturesque quality is due to the poplars, elms, oaks and maples lining the streets and being surrounded by streams and rivers, of which trout fishing has become a famous pastime. This morning we visit Bonnie B's Shaker Shed where we can see an eccentric collection of over 3000 salt and pepper shakers! Next is the Tumut Valley Violets where we'll immediately see the old school house that has been repurposed into this delightful venue. Our host will give us a talk on the farm and after some time to enjoy a stroll, we stay on for lunch. Ready with our sing-along voices, we head to the Montreal Theatre which opened to great excitement on 2 April 1930. Today we are treated to a guided tour of the theatre and a delicious afternoon tea as we watch old music reels from the comfort of our seats. Afterwards we'll be humming our way back to the hotel to relax prior to dinner.
