**Day 1: (D) CANBERRA TO AIRLIE BEACH: Sunday 23 June 2019**

Welcome aboard Potter Travel's 6 day tour to the Whitsundays and Airlie Beach. Today we make our way to the Canberra airport for our flights through to Proserpine (via Brisbane). Upon arrival this afternoon we are collected by our local operator who will be with us for the duration of our tour. Transferring to our accommodation, we'll settle in and unpack for the next 5 nights.

**Day 2: (BD) LOCAL SIGHTSEEING: Monday 24 June 2019**

This morning we are introduced to the local area with a sightseeing drive around Airlie Beach. We will also visit Proserpine, a sugar town and local service centre. Here we drop by the Historical Museum to learn about the local sugar and cattle industries. The establishment of a permanent museum in the Whitsunday region was a major initiative with strong support from the whole community. From here we head north to Bowen. After some time for lunch (own expense) we head off to see the many murals within the central business district. Bowen is actually known as the mural capital of Australia with 19 mural sites, many of which depict the town's early history. One of the murals was even designed by Ken Done. After our visit we reboard the coach and return to Airlie Beach.

**Day 3: (BLD) THE WHITSUNDAYS: Tuesday 25 June 2019**

After an early breakfast we prepare to board our full day cruise through the beautiful Whitsundays. During the day we'll visit Whitehaven Beach on the uninhabited Whitsunday Island. With 7 kilometres of glistening pure silica sand, Whitehaven Beach is nature at its most unspoilt and spectacular best. Take a stroll or maybe a swim in the crystal clear blue water. We also visit an inhabited island where we have time to have a look around and enjoy lunch. Later this afternoon, we return to the mainland, enjoying afternoon tea on the way.

#### **Day 4: (BLD) EARLANDO: Wednesday 26 June 2019**

Following a relaxed breakfast we head north towards Hideaway Bay and Dingo Beach. Our destination, a private property called Earlando, is a hidden gem of the Whitsundays with magnificent private beaches, panoramic views, abundant wildlife and a traditional working cattle station. This 6,500 acre cattle station has been in the same family for almost 50 years and our visit here today will be both memorable and interesting. Upon arrival we are joined on the coach by the owner who will introduce us to Earlando and take us to the lookout for superb views across Hayman Island whilst enjoying our morning tea. Returning to the beachfront later we enjoy a delicious Reef & Beef BBQ lunch, including fresh prawns! Later we visit the cattle yards for a cattle dog demonstration and learn about the secret life of a stockman. Prior to finishing our day, we have a traditional outback billy tea. Our visit complete, we farewell our hosts and return to our accommodation.

Reservations that are cancelled on or after **MON 22 APR** and prior to **MON 20 MAY 2019**: loss of 25% of total tour cost.

Reservations that are cancelled on or after **MON 20 MAY** and prior to **FRI 07 JUN 2019** : loss of 50% of total tour cost.

Reservations that are cancelled on or after **FRI 07 JUN 2019**: loss of 100% of total tour cost.

The \$50.00 Potter Travel administration fee only occurs when a refund cheque is issued. There is no administration fee for funds transferred to another Potter Travel tour. No shows on day of departure or cancellations whilst on tour will be charged a 100% cancellation fee.
