Join us and explore the beauty of the Riverina region. Celebrate heritage and historic experiences, highlighted by open gardens and crazy citrus sculptures at the annual Griffith Spring Festival.

Day 1: (LD): CANBERRA TO NARRANDERA: Tuesday 28 September 2021

With the coach loaded, we hit the road. Travelling via Gundagai and Wagga Wagga, we break for lunch in the charming town of Coolamon. The main street is a visual marvel of heritage architecture, reflecting a flourishing bygone era. Dining in the heritage building transforming Coolamon Cheeses into a cafe, we can wander through the courtyard featuring the original 1912 scotch oven. Before we leave town, let's drop by the Up To Date Store and Cultural Precinct. It's been said that anything and everything, from a plough to a piano, could be purchased from the Up-To-Date Store! It is a short journey through to our destination of Narrandera where we check into our accommodation and unpack for the next four nights.

Day 2: (BLD): DARLINGTON POINT & LEETON: Wednesday 29 September 2021

This morning we head directly to Altina Wildlife Park to enjoy a safari style tour. The park is home to a range of exotic animals, some of whom we may not have heard of before! Our guided tour is conducted in style, making our way around the park travelling on horse-drawn or motorised carts! Lunch is in the Rivadestra Café before continuing through to Leeton. Alighting the coach at the Visitors Centre we are given a welcome presentation and a Taste of Leeton tour. With a local expert joining us on the coach we embark on a **tour** of town, highlighting the points of interest along the way. A short drive delivers us back to our hotel.

Day 3: (BLD): EXPLORING NARRANDERA: Thursday 30 September 2021

This morning we set out to enjoy the tranquility of the Narrandera Memorial Gardens. Meander through the pretty gardens before getting your camera ready to capture the Royal Doulton Hankinson Fountain. There are only two of these fountains known to be in existence. One of the delights of Narrandera is the Glendale Citrus & Hazelnut Orchard. Invited to board the 'Orchard Express' tractor-drawn carriage, we'll be welcomed into the orchard presenting the citrus and hazelnut plantings. A wonderful lunch awaits us on conclusion of our tour. This afternoon we experience the compelling Fisheries Centre educating us to the native and non-native fish species inhabiting the waters of the Murray, Murrumbidgee, Lachlan and Darling River systems.

Day 4: (BLD): GRIFFITH: Friday 01 October 2021

Our day is spent in Griffith getting to know the town and their local produce having made them synonymous as the Riverina's Food Bowl. On our tour be rewarded with interesting tales of the locals who have called this town home and a visit to a local garden. Arriving at Careri Gardens we'll be immediately inspired by the beauty of their vineyards and orange trees. As we meander through the garden there are plenty of serene spots to take a break, including the gazebo overlooking a pond filled with water lilies and irises. A delightful light lunch follows. This afternoon is spent at Pioneer Park where a round of activities awaits us. Stepping back in time, explore some 40 historic buildings showing the development of Griffith. Enjoying a train ride through the park will complete our day before heading back to Narrandera.

Day 5: (BL): HEADING HOME VIA JUNE: Saturday 02 October 2021

Departing Narrandera, we prepare to stir our curiosity and tempt our tastebuds as we make our way to June. First up is the Monte Cristo Homestead to experience life from a bygone era and view a magnificent collection of fine antiques. As we tour this Victorian homestead we'll hear the intriguing past and present stories deeming Monte Cristo as Australia's most haunted house. Next stop is the June Liquorice and Chocolate Factory to enjoy lunch and be led through the inner workings of this delicious factory. It is only one of three certified organic liquorice manufactures in the world. After our stop we continue the last part of our onward journey. We arrive safely back in Canberra and head home with long lasting wonderful memories of our Riverina tour.
