Day 1 (D): CANBERRA TO AIRLIE BEACH: Sunday 16 August 2021

After time to buy some lunch we head off to see the many murals within the central business district. Bowen is actually known as the Mural Capital of Australia with 19 mural sites, many of which depict the town's early history. One of the murals was even designed by Ken Done. After our visit we reboard the coach and return to Airlie Beach.

the cattle yards for a cattle dog demonstration and learn about the secret life of a stockman. Prior to finishing our day, we have a traditional outback billy tea. Our visit complete, we farewell our hosts and return to our accommodation.
