Day 1: (LD): CANBERRA TO OBERON: Saturday 28 March 2020

With the coach loaded, we are ready to depart Canberra for a visit to the central tablelands and the central west. Our morning stop is in Goulburn, home to the Big Merino, before continuing onto **Taralga** for lunch. As we make our way north, dramatic natural landscapes will make way to pine forests and rolling farmlands on approach into our destination of **Oberon**. Sitting on the western fall of the Blue Mountains, it's a beautiful town taking its name from one of William Shakespeare's characters in *Midsummer Night's Dream*. A **local expert** will join us on the coach for a wonderful insight into Oberon's rural way of life. Tonight we stay at the Big Trout Motel.

Day 2: (BLD) OBERON TO PARKES: Sunday 29 March 2020

Visiting **Mayfield Gardens** we explore one of the largest privately owned cool climate gardens in the world. Starting life as a small working farm, the gardens developed spectacularly and we'll be amazed at the many features including the **Water Garden**. Following plenty of time to discover both the unique garden and nursery for a bit of retail therapy, we head to **Millthorpe** for lunch, prepared by the local CWA. Our afternoon stop is in **Manildra** where we'll drop by the **Amusu Theatre** to hear about the transformation of the Touring Talkies. Shortly we arrive into Parkes for a two night stay. Dinner this evening will be provided by the Parkes CWA.



Day 3: (BLD): EXPLORING PARKES: Monday 30 March 2020

This morning we take a look around the town named after the famous statesman Henry Parkes. The **CSIRO Radio Telescope Complex**, with the familiar 'Dish' used to receive live television images of the Apollo 11 moon landing, is welcoming and invites us to enjoy the hands on displays and exhibits. After travelling to Bogan Gate for lunch, made by the local CWA, we head to a very unique display near Condobolin. The **Utes in the Paddock** concept has taken iconic utes and turned them into displays of art – all with a truly Australiana theme! Returning to Parkes, we again head out to enjoy dinner together.

Continuing onto **Young** we meet the last of the local CWA ladies who have organised our **lunch** for us. The final leg of our journey is through Boorowa and Yass. We'll arrive back in Canberra having had a wonderfully memorable tour as well as supporting the local communities along the way.
