WELCOME BACK

Dear Travel Club Members

Well, 2020 has not panned out the way expected when we sent you the Summer Newsletter. The good news is given the challenges of Covid-19 we are all still here ready to get out and tour the great Australian outdoors. We hope to **RESTART on Tue 01 Sept 2020** with something that is a bit different (see page 2). Government restrictions may make it difficult for us to run our **Spring Mystery** on **Monday 07 September** even though it does not go anywhere near the Sydney area. Our tours to Mallacoota, Red Rock Cruise, the November Riverboat Postman, Charlotte Pass, the Summer Mystery in December and Norfolk Island in March 2021 are fully booked or have limited seats available at this stage.

This slimmed down Newsletter is to let you know what else we have on offer over the next 6 months as well as what we have planned for 2021 (see the adjacent column). A full newsletter will be produced in the Spring.

We have a mix of tours that have been rescheduled from 2020 to 2021 as well as new tours on offer. Some of the new 2020 tours travel to the NSW South Coast as we try and help our coastal neighbours and those local communities emerge from both the bushfire tragedies as well as Covid-19.

Some 2020 tours rescheduled for 2021 have firm dates and prices. The issues with Virgin Australia means tours with an airfare component rescheduled from 2020 to 2021 have a firm date but no tour cost. We will advise those tour costs as soon as we know the airfares. The **Australian Open Tennis** is still in our plans but we cannot get any tournament or ticketing details at this stage.

Musicals have been hard hit by Covid-19 and **Frozen** is the only production to reschedule and we have a date in February 2021. As other musicals come back on line we will let you know. We have rescheduled affected day tours plus have others on offer, some of which head to the South Coast to help those communities. But there is plenty else to see and do and we hope to welcome you back onboard very soon.

WE ARE A COVID REGISTERED BUSINESS

Due to Covid-19, we have introduced a range of protocols to help keep you safe on tour. This includes signing a disclosure form pre tour that you have no likely symptoms or been in contact with anyone who has; having your temperature taken before boarding; providing hand sanitiser at the entrance to the coach to use upon boarding; dedicated seating where possible to assist in a 1.5 metre separation; providing antiseptic wipes for those who wish to wipe down their personal area. Coach crew have the Covid-19 app on their mobile phone and heavy use areas on the coach will be regularly cleaned. Tour suppliers used on the tours will be encouraged to have Covid-19 hygiene guidelines and when visiting any areas with other members of the public members will be encouraged to maintain social distancing.

10 DAY TOOWOOMBA CARNIVAL OF FLOWERS & O'REILLY'S RETREAT Tuesday 22 September 2020

This tour incorporates two of southern Queensland's iconic attractions—the Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers and O'Reilly's Rainforest Retreat. Travel via northern NSW to Toowoomba for a 3 night stay. The Carnival of Flowers is Australia's longest-running annual horticultural event, a cultural party



featuring spectacular gardens and all things spring. This year the Festival will be slightly different than in a normal year but still many festival activities and local attractions to enjoy. From here we head across to O'Reilly's Rainforest Retreat in the Lamington National Park where it has been welcoming travellers for over 93 years to relax, experience and connect with nature. After a 2 night stay we head home via the New England Tablelands and Gloucester. *Tour subject to Qld border restrictions being eased.*

FISH 'N' CHIPS ON THE CLYDE Wednesday 23 September 2020



Let's help the South Coast which has suffered so badly the last 6 months. The Clyde River is pristine, flowing through over 100km of NSW national park and state forests. Enjoy the famous Innes Fish 'n' Chips on board the MV Merinda as you sit back and watch the river meandering slowly, each bend revealing the river's

many moods and faces. Our cruise takes us up river to the historic little river port of **Nelligen**, where in past times sailing and steam ships plied their trade. We have half an hour to stretch our legs and take a wander around the village before cruising back down the Clyde River. After disembarking we reboard the coach and travel to Braidwood for an afternoon stop before heading home. A maximum of 25 allowed on this tour.

Mayfield Gardens, Millthorpe and the Amusu Theatre are part of our itinerary as we head for a 2 night stay in Parkes, the town named after the famous statesman Henry Parkes. The CSIRO Radio Telescope Complex and a very unique display near Condobolin called The Utes in the Paddock are part of this itinerary before we head home via Grenfell and Young.

with surprises at every turn! Afterwards we enjoy lunch at the **Graze Restaurant** as well as a tour & talk at the **Junee licorice factory**. You will have plenty of opportunity to stock up on the wonderful organic licorice and other treats! This tour date may change subject to travel restrictions affecting 2020 tours.

4 DAY MERIMBULA & SOUTH COAST Friday 30 October 2020



The NSW South Coast has been hit by bushfires during their peak holiday period then Covid-19 as they tried to recover. So let's spend 4 days in an area in real need of visitors. We will be based in the beautiful town of Merimbula, an enchanting seaside town on the sparkling Sapphire Coast that offers rugged ocean beaches and tranquil coastal lakes. The name is derived from a local Aboriginal word



meaning 'two lakes', a reference to Merimbula Lake on the southern side of the town and the smaller Back Lake on the northern side. The tour includes the local sights of Merimbula, a whale watching cruise on Twofold Bay, a visit to an Angora Goat Farm in the beautiful Towamba Valley, a stop in at Wheelers Oyster Farm and lunch at Foxglove Spires Garden.

Young. A close contender in the **Battle of the Sites** for the Federal Capital Territory, Bombala was narrowly pipped at the post by Canberra. If Bombala won, Government House would almost certainly have been **'Burnima'**. Today we have a guided tour of the elegant two storey Victorian Homestead and gardens with lunch included at Bombala. *This tour date may change subject to travel restrictions affecting 2020 tours*.

JUGIONG COUNTRY EXPERIENCE Wednesday 25 November 2020





Both our 2020 tours to Norfolk Island had to be rescheduled to 2021. The island lies about 1700kms east of Sydney, a volcanic island made up of undulating hill country, with steep cliffs rising from the ocean and a fascinating history. Discovered by Captain Cook it was twice settled and abandoned as a Convict Settlement. The original buildings are beautifully restored and on display. Its third and permanent settlement came with the relocation of the descendants of the



famous mutineers of the Bounty from the tiny island of Pitcairn in the mid 1800s. Today the families of these descendants are prominent. The history and scenery make this a memorable holiday. Our accommodation is at the South Pacific Resort Hotel and our touring on the island is with Baunti Escapes.
