Only a two-hour flight from Sydney with limited visitors allowed on the untouched island at any one time, come join us to experience the islands incredible natural attractions.

**Day 1: (D): CANBERRA – LORD HOWE ISLAND: Monday 10 May 2021**

Welcome to our tour to stunning Lord Howe Island. We make our own way to Canberra Airport where we board our flights to Lord Howe Island via Sydney. On arrival we are met by our local host at the airport and transferred to our accommodation. This afternoon we travel to the Museum where we'll be given a lecture by Ian Hutton. Ian is the curator of the museum and a passionate environmentalist, saying "living on Lord Howe Island is like living inside a David Attenborough documentary". Dinner tonight is at the Coral Café, located in the museum, giving us a chance to look through some of the displays.

**Day 2: (BLD): ORIENTATION: Tuesday 11 May 2021**

We are collected from breakfast for our Chase 'N' Thyme Half Day Island Tour. This tour gives a fascinating insight into the flora, fauna and unique island way of life. We learn about the history from early settlement until now and are also invited in to the home of a local for morning tea. Our tour includes an explanation of every venue on the island including the waste and recycling centre (which is more interesting than you may imagine!). We meet up at the Bowling Club for dinner.

**Day 3: (BLD): NORTH BAY: Wednesday 12 May 2021**

After lunch, we have a "Big Day Out" planned today as our Marine Adventures team will take us on an in-depth tour of the North Bay of the island. Here we can view the large variety of fish, turtles, stingrays and incredible coral. The islands history of marine life will be portrayed with the relaxed commentary through the eyes of a sixth-generation islander before an opportunity to snorkel in the waters with some of the best visibility available. Tonight, we are off to the Anchorage Restaurant, our hosts for dinner.

**Day 4: (BD): CRUISING THE ISLAND: Thursday 13 May 2021**

This morning on our Around Island Cruise we get up close to the stunning vertical cliffs of Mount Gower and Mount Lidgbird. We also have the chance to spot Balls Pyramid in the distance before cruising past the Admiralty Isles, see the arch, the Gulch and Herring Pools. Bird life is in abundance on the island and it's a great opportunity to see some of them such as the red-tailed tropic bird, sooty terns and common noddy that nest on the cliffs and outer islands. We take a glass bottom boat trip on the lagoon. The brilliant blue lagoon is formed by a natural barrier of 6km of the world's southernmost coral reef.

The waters are home to more than 500 species of fish and 90 species of coral. We'll see beautiful coral outcrops, surging strands of algae, colourful sponges and a wonderful array of fish life as we cruise over Cornets Hole and Erscotts Hole. Tonight, we enjoy dinner at the picturesque Golf Club.

**Day 5: (BLD): LITTLE ISLAND CREATIVITY: Friday 14 May 2021**

We enjoy a Little Island Walk with our guide who will take a comfortable pace allowing a chance for commentary along the way. We make our way to Ginny's Shed, where we have a chance to do some of our own artwork! Its here we can see island inspired, hand painted and dyed textiles using natural materials. Today we will have made a perfect souvenir of our time on Lord Howe Island. This evening we sample another restaurant on the island, Beach House on the Moon at Milky Way. The menu often offers fresh fish caught by local fishermen and as much local produce as possible.

**Day 6: (BD): RAMBLING RONNIE: Saturday 15 May 2021**

We'll meet our friend "Ramblin Ronnie" for an interesting tour. We'll be kept informed and at times amused as we wander through unique forest and listen to some interesting tales on our way. On our tour, we may also encounter the Lord Howe Island Woodhen, a brown flightless bird. After being almost extinct in the 1970s the island created a successful breeding program and now have a stable population. Our afternoon is free to do as we wish. Options include hiring a bike to see the island at our own pace, take a walk, go for a swim, arrange a fishing trip or simply relax with a good book. We meet up for our farewell dinner at the Bowling Club.

Reservations that are cancelled prior to **WED 10 MAR 2021**. Full refund of deposit less \$55 airline deposit and \$50.00 administration fee.

Reservations that are cancelled on or after **WED 10 MAR 2021 but before FRI 09 APR 2021**: loss of 50% of total tour cost.

Reservations that are cancelled on or after **FRI 09 APR 2021**: No refund, loss of 100% of total tour cost.

The taxable component of the airfare is subject to change without notice. Any changes to airfare details will incur a fee of \$125. The \$50.00 Potter Travel administration fee only occurs when a refund cheque is issued. There is no administration fee for funds transferred to another Potter Travel tour. No shows on day of departure or cancellations whilst on tour will be charged a 100% cancellation fee. Where Potter Travel cancels the tour as a result of insufficient numbers or due to reasons within Potter Travel's control, a full refund of any monies paid at the time of cancellation will be given.
