Taking a **guided tour** through **Jillabenan Cave**, a small yet accessible cave, it is packed with incredibly detailed formations. Back in Tumut, we visit **Tumut Valley Violets** located in the old, repurposed school house. Enjoying a delicious lunch, our hosts will uncover the secrets behind growing these gorgeous plants. After time to take a stroll we anticipate our final visit at the heritage listed **Montreal Theatre**. Treated to a **guided tour and a delicious afternoon tea**, our excitement will build as we settle into the comfort of our seats. Be moved by the scenes before us as we **watch old music reels**, taking us back to the treasured times of our past. Afterwards we'll be humming our way back to the hotel.

Day 3: (BLD): BOGGY CREEK SHOW: Friday 26 March 2021 Today we visit the **Boggy Creek Show** for an outstanding depiction of the unique Snowy Mountain heritage. The family's presence for three generations in these wild and wonderful mountains has left them with a legacy from the past, with which they live today. Be inspired with breathtaking landscapes as we experience the **authentic mountain farm show**. The live performance combines the skills of horsemanship, mustering, working Kelpie dogs and unique Aussie humour. For lunch we visit one of the most unusual small museums, **The Pioneer Womens Hut**. The cleverly themed museum reflects the ingenuity of women in finding solutions to the challenges of looking after a family in early rural Australia. The museum features an excellent collection of domestic artefacts, agricultural machinery and local crafts.

Day 4: (BL): TUMUT TO CANBERRA: Saturday 27 March 2021

Our last day begins with a visit to the popular **Tumut Broom Factory**. The district grows the highest-grade broom millet in NSW and 90% of the State's requirements come from this area. The crop is sown in November and harvested in February. After threshing out the gain, the stems are brought to the factory in Adelong Road to be made into brooms. On our way home, we stop in the heritage listed township of **Adelong**. With a **specialist** joining us, we'll be shown the **Adelong Falls Gold Mill Ruins**. A state listed industrial site, the remarkable stone ruins show ingenuity from the era of alluvial gold mining along Adelong Creek. Continuing through to Bowning let's call in for **lunch** before making tracks for Canberra and home.
