A DAY OUT





Adelong is the heritage gateway to the Snowy Mountains with it's main street classified by the National Trust (NSW) with some buildings dating back to the gold rush era of the 1800's. The site was first established in 1864 as the Commercial Hotel during the 'Gold Rush' days. Destroyed by fire in the early 1920's it was rebuilt in 1926 as the existing 2-storey structure. In later

years it then became the 'Gold Reef Hotel' which continued trading as a pub and hotel until 1978. First known as the Beaufort Guesthouse before being renamed Beaufort House, it retains its unique 1900's style establishment with reminders of yesteryear throughout the building such as the frosted 'CH' Commercial Hotel symbol on the window panes.

HAWKESBURY WORKING KELPIE STUD Friday 08 October 2021



This sell out tour has been so popular we are doing another in the Spring. **The Hawkesbury Working Kelpie Stud** is located near **Young** and promotes the working Kelpie by way of working dog demonstrations. It all started with Anthony taking his Kelpie team to the 2011 Sydney Royal Easter Show. It was a big hit with up to 600 people attending each demonstration. Their understanding and vast experience with working Kelpies is

proven by their achievements in Yard dog and three sheep trialling. We enjoy morning tea and a demonstration today followed by lunch in **Young** before heading home via Harden so we can view the amazing Silo Art.

BINALONG HOTEL CHRISTMAS IN JULY Tuesday 20 July 2021

Built around a village square the historic heritage village of **Binalong** is nestled in wooded hills north-west of Yass. In 1821 Hamilton Hume was the first known European in the area. It was also home to **AB 'Banjo' Paterson** who was raised just outside the town. Australian bushranger, Johnny (Flash) Gilbert, lies buried near Binalong. Once a major stopping place for Cobb & Co Coaches,



Binalong is now home to some outstanding examples of colonial architecture. The Black Swan Inn (1847) is now a gallery, the original Paterson Pub (1840's), is a private residence, as is the old railway station (1876). Today we enjoy a 2-course **Christmas luncheon** at Hotel Binalong.

CAMDEN VALLEY TOUR Thursday 09 September 2021

NEW TOUR. Discover the rural and historic beauty of **Camden**. We are joined by a local guide who will tell us all about the industrious MacArthur family and the legacies they left to the nation, as well as showing us some of the early colonial buildings. After our tour we head to the Camden Valley Inn for a delicious lunch. This afternoon we travel to Goulburn to the historic Riversdale Homestead. Standing within



its original paddocks and outbuildings, it is a fine example of a Colonial Georgian home surrounded by splendid gardens and picnic grounds. Built in the late 1830s as a coaching inn, Riversdale later became home to the district surveyor, Edward Twynam and his family who occupied it for almost 100 years prior to its purchase by the National Trust.

NEW TOUR. Visit **Laurel View**, the Maugers working farm to learn more about grass-fed beef and lamb production. Find out why raising livestock naturally on grass is better for the animal, the environment and the taste. Our tour is hosted by John and Vicki Mauger and includes morning tea on arrival followed by an introduction to the farm, the Mauger family and their grass-fed beef and lamb



farming methods. 'Meet the Mob' with a walk across the paddocks to see the grazing animals amidst breathtaking **Southern Highlands** views. Learn about different breeds on the farm, how and why they are selected. This is followed by the 'Art of Butchery' demonstration, where the master butcher breaks down beef, explaining each cut, what to look for when you are buying your meat and taking questions. Then the plate part! A sumptuous lunch of slow roasted Maugers produce.

NEW TOUR. Markdale is a working sheep and cattle station in the Great Dividing Ranges near Crookwell. The property is rich in history and features a five acre award-winning **Edna Walling garden** and rambling homestead, a remarkable mirror of the elegance of the decades stretching from the '30s to the present. As well as being a property

with great historical value, Markdale is renowned for its international association with the game of polo and agricultural merits. Also over the years Markdale has been featured in many books and publications and is known as one of Australia's great country gardens. We enjoy a morning stop in Crookwell before a late morning arrival at Markdale for a tour, lunch and time to enjoy the award winning gardens.
