DAY 1: (LD) CANBERRA TO MAITLAND: SATURDAY 6 AUGUST 2022

Good morning fellow travellers! On our incredible tour, we make our way up the New South Wales and Queensland coast to World Heritage Listed Fraser Island. Today we head through Sydney and the Central Coast to Maitland, stopping for convenience breaks and a delicious club lunch. We arrive at our motel with free time to settle in before our welcome dinner.

DAY 2: (BD) MAITLAND TO TENTERFIELD: SUNDAY 7 AUGUST 2022

We continue up the New South Wales coast passing Armidale and Glen Innes as we make our way to todays destination, Tenterfield. It was here in October 1889 that Sir Henry Parkes made his famous speech which set in motion the popular movement resulting in the federation of Australia.

DAY 3: (BLD) TENTERFIELD TO HERVEY BAY: MONDAY 8 AUGUST 2022

We have a travel day ahead as we cross the border into Queensland. Today we bypass Brisbane and the Sunshine Coast. We enjoy a delightful light lunch at Pelican Waters Tavern, offering a spectacular water views over the scenic canals. We arrive in Hervey Bay, the gateway to stunning Fraser Island and known for the incredible whale watching offshore in the Marine Park.

DAY 4: (BD) HERVEY BAY TO FRASER ISLAND: TUESDAY 9 AUGUST 2022

After breakfast we have a chance to wander through the delightful Botanic Gardens before spending the remainder of the morning at Hervey Bay Historical Village and Museum, where we are taken back to yesteryear with historical buildings and collections from the region. Preserving some of the Hervey Bay history, we can walk through the museum that includes over 21 buildings from those early days, examine over 12,000 items, both large and small, and discover what life was like for the people who settled in this area. We begin our afternoon with a ferry crossing to Fraser Island. Known as K'gari (meaning paradise) by the traditional owners, the Butchulla people, the islands diverse landscapes and unique wildlife entice tourist to its shores every year. We have time at leisure on arrival where you can enjoy the resorts facilities.

DAY 5: (BLD) DISCOVER FRASER ISLAND: WEDNESDAY 10 AUGUST 2022

We discover Fraser Islands ancient sand dunes, long stretches of white sandy beaches, freshwater lakes and lush rainforests on our 4WD tour. Feel the pure white silica sand between our toes and swim in the crystal-clear water as we discover Lake McKenzie. Next, we visit Maheno Shipwreck, the most famous wreck on the island that washed ashore 75 Mile Beach during a cyclone. On our travels, look out for the islands incredible dingo population, renowned as the purest breed in Australia. Having had a magnificent day seeing this stunning sand island, we return to our resort for dinner.

DAY 8: (BD) GOLD COAST: SATURDAY 13 AUGUST 2022


