

Carrington Inn, Bungendore Thursday 11th August

NEIL DIAMOND TRIBUTE SHOW Thursday 11 August 2022

Enjoy a day out to Bungendore where we have a delicious lunch at The Carrington and a tribute to the life, music and immense talent of song writing genius of Neil Diamond. Close your eyes and listen to the voice of Shane Tapper - you'll swear you are listening to the man himself. Shane will take you on a musical voyage from Diamond's early days as a songwriter with Bang Records in New York City in the mid 60's, to his hit songs as a solo artist in L.A. All the hits from Neil Diamond's self-titled albums to Hot August Night and the Jazz Singer in the late 70's. This show will have you singing and dancing along. Afterwards there is a little time to explore historic Bungendore before heading home.

We will depart Canberra around the middle of the day and get back late evening but it is Tulip Time with a difference.

RETFORD PAK ESTATE Friday 07 October 2022

Retford Park was acquired by Samuel Hordern in the 1880s, who named the property in recognition of his family links to Retford in England. Retford Park House was completed in 1887. Following the death of Samuel Hordern III in 1960, the American Company, King Ranch, purchased the property. Over the years architect Espie Dods added architecturally sympathetic extensions to the home and Melbourne landscape architect David Wilkinson contributed the Knot Garden, the Green Room and the Millennium Canal to Retford Park's tranquil gardens. In April 2016 John Fairfax gifted this historic home to the National Trust of Australia.

You'll marvel at the sight and sounds of antique street organs, European dance hall organs, the rockin' robot band, the 100 year old steam merry-go-round, the selfplaying violins and the grand Taj Mahjal - one of the world's largest, most elaborate selfplaying instruments. Finish this tour with a nostalgic ride on the elaborately carved 100 year old carousel with its stirring music.

BOWRAL TULIP FESTIVAL Tuesday 20 September 2022


For those who would just prefer a day out to see the Tulips and some of the gardens in the Southern Highlands we will also be running a more traditional Tulip Time day tour. Enjoy a morning visit to **Red Cow Farm**, a unique cool climate garden set on 2.5 hectares in the picturesque rural village of Sutton Forest that has been described as one of the best in the world. We then head to Bowral where there is plenty of time to enjoy the displays at **Corbett Gardens** and wander the Bowral shops which are right next door. We return home late afternoon after spending the day in the Bowral.

FISH 'N' CHIPS ON THE CLYDE Wednesday 12 October 2022

The Clyde River is pristine, flowing through over 100km of NSW national park and state forests. Enjoy the famous Innes Fish 'n' Chips on board the **MV Merinda** as you sit back and watch the river meandering slowly, each bend revealing the river's many moods and faces. Our cruise takes us up river to the historic little river port of **Nelligen**, where in past times sailing and steam ships plied their trade. We have half an hour to stretch our legs and take a wander around the village before cruising back down the river to Batemans Bay. After disembarking we reboard the coach and travel to Braidwood for an afternoon stop before heading home.

DAY OUT IN 2022

WARBIRDS AT TEMORA SATURDAY 15 OCTOBER 2022

The largest **Warbirds Air Show** in the Southern Hemisphere will once again take flight over **Temora** in October 2022. This event is jam-packed with action, in the air and on the ground, making for a great day out. The day is filled with a curated program of historical warbird flight, the full line-up of aircraft will be published as the airshow approaches. The program will offer an array of aircraft from trainers to jets. It will include the full on-site RAAF 100 Sqn collection of working warbirds housed at Temora Aviation Museum, and many more rare and unique former and current military aircraft.

PADDOCK TO PLATE Tuesday 15 November 2022

Visit Laurel View to learn more about grassfed beef and lamb production. Our tour is hosted by John and Vicki Mauger and includes morning tea followed by an introduction to the farm, the Mauger family and their grass-fed beef and lamb farming methods. 'Meet the Mob' and see the grazing animals amidst breathtaking Southern Highlands views. This is followed by the 'Art of Butchery' demonstration, where the master butcher breaks down beef, explaining each cut, what to look for when you are buying your meat and taking questions. Then the plate part! A sumptuous lunch of slow roasted Maugers produce.

After our visit we head to **Allambie Orchard** where we enjoy lunch including cherry pie, a tour and a talk on cherries. Here you can pick your own cherries, or there will be pre-packed cherries for sale.



CINDERELLA THE MUSICAL Wednesday 07 December 2022






