Day 1: (LD): CANBERRA TO ORANGE: Friday 23 December 2022

Welcome aboard our tour to **Orange**, bringing together a mix of gourmet tastings and stunning natural surroundings as we celebrate **Christmas and the festive season**. Travelling via Boorowa and Cowra, we head to the small, yet charming township of **Carcoar**. Stopping at the historic Stoke House we enjoy lunch in tranquil surroundings at the delightful **Teapots Café**. Meeting our **local guide**, we learn about the town recognised as the third oldest settlement west of the Blue Mountains. Ending the tour at possibly the oldest building in town, the convict-built **Stoke Stable Museum** still has evidence of the building's early roof shingles. After our country hospitality, we continue through to **Orange** to check into our hotel and settle into our rooms.

Day 2: (BLD): EXPLORING ORANGE: Saturday 24 December 2022

A **local expert** joins us this morning to unveil **Orange** including the impressive native and exotic plant collections within the Botanic Gardens. Heading out of town we visit **Hillside Harvest**. This 75-acre property proudly yields many varieties of fruit and is passionate about food, on arrival we enjoy a walk through the orchard followed by a lovely **lunch** served using delicious fresh produce. Following lunch we travel to the small goldrush village of Lucknow to visit a couple of local enterprises. The **Lucknow Skin Shop and Boot Barn** is a family run business with a strong history in sheepskin spanning three generations and **Larder & Home** offers beautiful kitchen and homewares. We return to Orange to relax before dinner.

Day 3: (BLS): MERRY CHRISTMAS: Sunday 25 December 2022

Merry Christmas! There will be time to attend church services this morning if you wish. Sprucing ourselves up we prepare for our **Christmas Lunch with all the trimmings**! The afternoon can be filled with post-Christmas lunch snoozing or simply relaxing. A light supper will be offered for those who are feeling peckish.

Day 4: (BLD): EXPLORING LOCALLY: Monday 26 December 2022

Exploring to the west today, we begin in **Manildra** with a visit to the art deco **Amusu Theatre.** Opened in 1936 by Allan Tom, the theatre has been operated by the same family since. Be taken on a trip down memory lane watching a couple of 'golden oldie' short movies! Next door is a bounty of original movie posters – all for sale. Travelling across to Molong, we find a quaint historic village and the **Molong Yarn Market** where we'll break for **lunch.** Housed in the 19th century 'Coach House' we'll also view the famous tapestry created by the people of Molong and district. Nearing Orange, we drop into **Norland Fig Orchard** where we will be welcomed to their farm and told a little bit about the journey of the fig. With an opportunity to taste their pastes, chutneys and relishes, we'll also enjoy afternoon tea including fig jam before continuing back to our hotel.

Day 5: (BL): ORANGE TO CANBERRA: Tuesday 27 December 2022

Packing our belongings we begin our return journey home. We stop in **Canowindra** for a visit to the **Age of Fishes Museum**, home to some very rare and important fish fossils, linking fish to the first amphibians. From Canowindra we continue to **Young** for our lunch break. As its cherry season let's make **Allambie Orchard** our lunch destination where we also have the chance to do some cherry picking. Our afternoon drive back to Canberra sees us arrive home completing our relaxed Christmas holiday with our friends.
