SCHNAPPS & SNOWIES Thursday 26 October 2023

The Snowy Region is renowned for its pristine and natural beauty. The Snowy Hydro Discovery Centre is a state-of-the-art visitor facility showcasing the story of the Snowy Mountains Scheme from the early days, to the role it plays today. We then travel to Jindabyne for lunch. Our last stop of the day is the Wildbrumby Distillery which produces purely Australian schnapps made from fruits locally grown on the southwest slopes of NSW. Fruit is sourced from both the adjacent raspberry farm and from local producers in the Tumut, Batlow and Snowy Mountains region.

FISH 'N' CHIPS ON THE CLYDE WEDNESDAY 17 JANUARY 2024

The Clyde River is pristine, flowing through over 100km of NSW national park and state forests. Enjoy the famous Innes Fish 'n' Chips on board the MV Merinda as you sit back and watch the river meandering slowly, each bend revealing the river's many moods and faces. Our cruise takes us up river to the historic little river port of Nelligen, where in past times sailing and steam ships plied their trade. 




