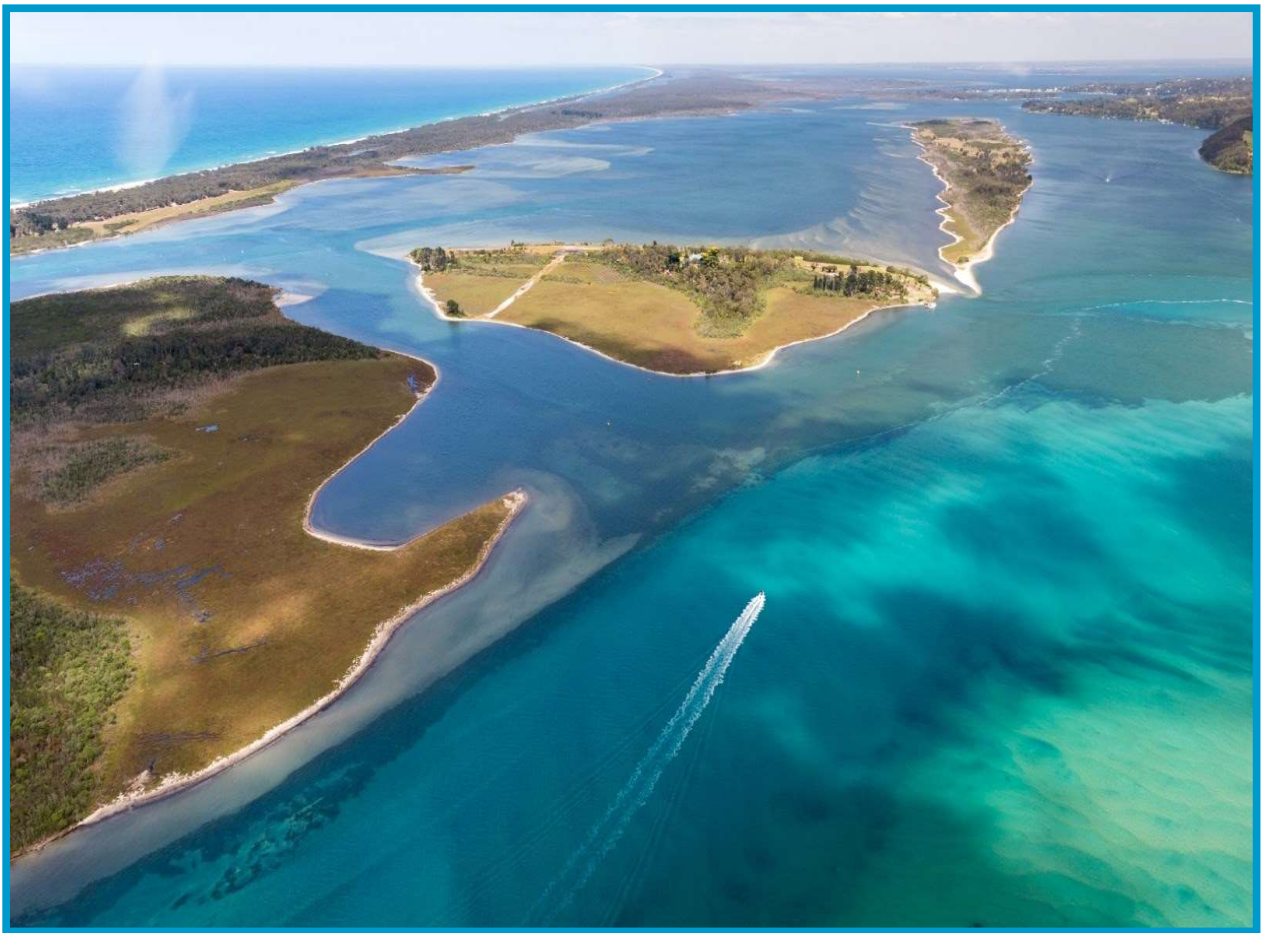

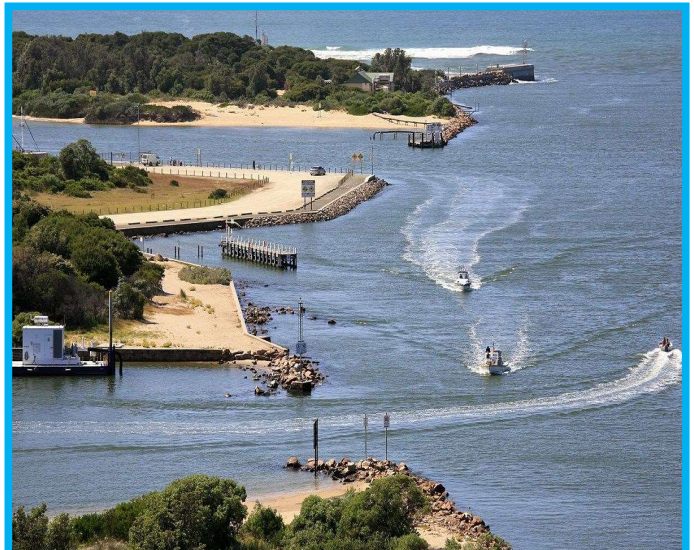
Day 1: (LD) CANBERRA TO LAKES ENTRANCE: Mon 28 October 2024

Welcome aboard our tour to **Lakes Entrance**, where we have based ourselves at the comfortable and very welcoming **Esplanade Motel**. Ready for departure, settle into your seats and enjoy the scenery as we travel through Cooma and Bombala, arriving into Cann River for a **lunch** break. Reaching **Lakes Entrance** we have time to visit the **Sea Shell Museum** with its amazing treasure trove of shells and marine life and surprisingly a miniature train set on display. Checking into our accommodation, we unpack for the next 3 nights.

Day 2: (BLD) LOCAL SIGHTS: Tuesday 29 October 2024

Our travel's today takes us to **Orbost**, we take time out to view the **Orbost Exhibition Centre**. Located on the Snowy River, the exhibition is all about timber and includes the National Collection of Wood Design, permanently on display here. Designed on several levels we have time to enjoy a retail showroom, gallery for professional artists and a top level for views over the Forest Park. Ready for lunch we venture on to **Marlo** where the Snowy meets the sea. Perched on the hill overlooking the estuaries, the **Historic Marlo Hotel** gives us a wonderful view while we enjoy our lunch. Rounding out our day is a stop at the remarkable **Nyerimilang Park**. Situated by a tranquil lake, this homestead served as a retreat for fishing enthusiasts during the late 1800s. The rich history of Nyerimilang can be explored by a self-guided tour, enhanced by the intriguing assortment of exotic and native plants in the semi-formal gardens. We return to Lakes Entrance via a stop at the Jemmys Point lookout for great views of the lakes and Bass Strait.

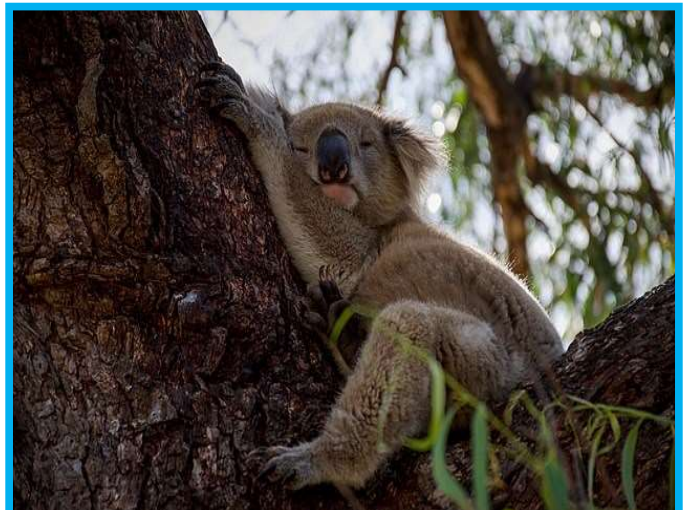


Day 3: (BLD) THE STOCKYARD SHOW: Wed 30 October 2024

Travelling through Bairnsdale to Paynesville, we join the ferry linking the mainland to the nature-based **Raymond Island**. Here we meet a very special horseman with many years' experience handling horses. Don't forget the camera and of course, in true outback hospitality, the billy will be on the boil for us along with a lovely **morning tea**. Wayne's passion is his horses and during the live **Stockyard Show** demonstration we'll be enchanted by the skills and talents as the entertainment unfolds. The show has whip cracking, music and singing, working dogs and much more. As Tommy Woodcock's Foreman of years gone by, we'll be regaled with stories of Phar Lap and see the large collection of Phar Lap memorabilia. Departing Raymond Island we re-trace our steps to Paynesville for **lunch** before our visit to **Krowathunkooloong Keeping Place**. We'll immerse ourselves in the heritage and culture of Aboriginal East Gippsland including an exhibition of contemporary aboriginal art then make our way back to our hotel.

Day 4: (BL) LAKES ENTRANCE TO CANBERRA: Thurs 31 Oct 2024

Farewelling our Lakes Entrance hosts, we make tracks for home. We'll stop in Bombala for a break including lunch, then continue to Canberra completing our coastal summer tour.

CANCELLATION BY YOU: You may cancel your booking by giving written notice to us or calling our reservation team. Cancellation fees and charges will be levied as follows irrespective of when notice of cancellation is received:

1. any amounts we have paid or have contractually committed to pay to third parties to deliver your travel arrangements that we cannot reasonably recover (for example payments made or due to hotels, airlines, cruise companies);
2. where we operate any of the services included in your travel arrangements (for example, coach travel), a reasonable amount attributable to such services which we determine we cannot resell;
3. a fee which is the greater of the deposit and 20% of the booking value to compensate us for work performed up until the time of cancellation;
4. a fee not greater than 5% of the booking value to compensate us for processing the cancellation and any associated refund.

Cancellation fees and charges will not exceed payments received by us at the time of cancellation. If after the application of these fees and charges there is a surplus of payments you have made to us, we will refund this to you within a reasonable time. You agree that these cancellation fees and charges are reasonable and required to protect our legitimate business interests. Any payments we have made to third parties will only be refunded to you once we have deducted the above cancellation fees and charges and once we have actually recovered the amounts from the third parties. We will use reasonable endeavours to recover third party payments, but we make no guarantee that we will be able to make recoveries.

The operation of the tour is subject to minimum numbers. Potter Travel reserves the right to pass on any additional fees or surcharges imposed by the airlines or wholesaler with or without notice. Potter Travel reserves the right to alter itineraries without notice due to weather, road conditions or any other reason which is seen to be in the best interest of passengers travelling.
