Day 2: (BLD) DAY AT SEA: Wednesday 24 July 2024

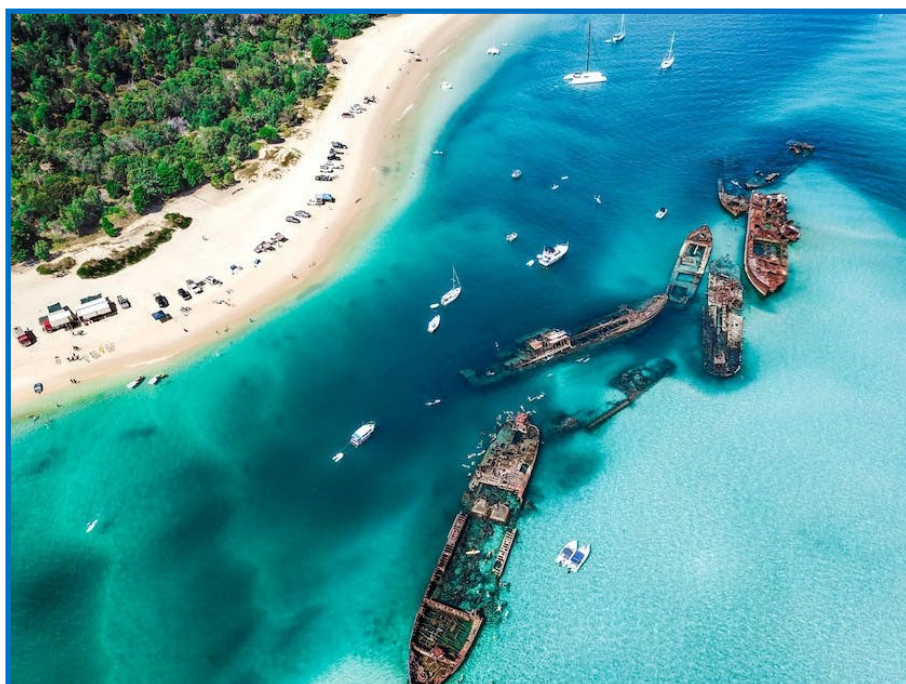

CRUISE DOCUMENTATION/CHECK IN

Cruise documentation will become available for fully paid reservations approximately 60 days prior to your departure. First we will need to complete an online check in, which we will assist you with. We will print all required documents for you to collect from your Tour Escort on the day of departure along with your travel wallet containing all relevant information for your cruise.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Onboard medical expenses are not covered under Australian Medicare . Onboard treatment is billed at private rates and if emergency evacuation is required it can cost thousands of dollars. Potter Travel requires all passengers to have taken out a travel insurance policy that covers cruise travel medical. It is also advisable to have in your policy cruise fare protection for unforeseen circumstances resulting in cancellation prior to travel, loss or damage to baggage and personal effects, illness, medical expenses, accidental injury, or emergency evacuation.

Shore Excursions for Moreton Island can be booked through P&O's Cruise Personaliser and onboard subject to availability. We will provide you with a shore excursions brochure and assist you with bookings.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

For domestic Cruises departing an Australian port that do not visit an international port, such as this cruise, a valid passport or government issued photo identification is required for all Adults. Accepted forms of government issued photo identification include a driver's licence, proof of age cards and Government ID cards.

VACCINATIONS– GUEST HEALTH

Although it is no longer a requirement, we strongly encourage all guests to remain up to date with vaccinations for COVID-19 and influenza. With the lifting of government COVID -19 requirements, it is no longer a requirement for all guests to take a COVID-19 test prior to boarding their cruise. Any guest reporting or exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms should notify our onboard medical staff and be seen for testing. Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 should isolate for at least 5 days from the day they test positive and until they have been symptom free for 24 hours.

NAME CHANGES

Once you have made your booking, please check your Booking Confirmation to ensure the details are correct. Should you need to make changes to your booking (spelling corrections or to replace a guest), cancellation or administration fees may apply. One original guest from the booking must always remain in the stateroom. This means that if you are sharing a twin room and one passenger needs to cancel with someone to take their place, we can replace the passenger rather than incurring cancel fees. However if the remaining guest then needs to change the name on their booking, this will not be permitted and cancellation fees would apply. Name Changes are not permitted on Sole Occupancy Cabins.

We will use reasonable endeavours to recover third party payments, but we make no guarantee that we will be able to make recoveries.
