Day 1 - (IFM) - 11th May 2025

SINGAPORE SIGHTSEEING

Day 2 - (B, L, D) - 12th May 2025

This morning, our local guide will meet us at the hotel to begin a city tour, including a visit to the National Orchid Gardens, home to the world's largest orchid collection, located within the UNESCO-listed Singapore Botanic Gardens. We'll also explore the Peranakan Museum, housed in the historic Tao Nan Chinese School, which offers a comprehensive look at the rich Peranakan culture. After lunch at the Fort Canning Hotel, we'll have time to explore Fort Canning Park, a historic landmark that has witnessed Singapore's transformation and now serves as a tranquil setting for various events. In the evening, we'll enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel.



***Today is Vesak Day in Singapore: Vesak Day commemorates the birth, enlightenment and nirvana of Gautama Buddha. The day begins with an early morning ceremony at temples, where the Buddhist flag is raised and hymns are sung. Devotees offer flowers, candles, and joss sticks, symbolizing life's impermanence.*

The day is dedicated to good deeds as devotees believe that performing good deeds on Vesak Day will multiply merit many times over. This day offers a glimpse into the spiritual and compassionate essence of Buddhism.



SINGAPORE ZOO & HIGH TEA

Day 3 - (B, L) - 13th May 2025

This morning, we visit the Singapore Zoo, where you can have breakfast 'in the wild' with animals such as Orangutans, African Penguins, Sealion, Bengal Eagle Owl (the exact animals are subject to rotation, weather and animal conditions on the day itself)! After breakfast we spend the morning at this fabulous attraction. Since 1973, Singapore Zoo has been known for having among the most beautiful wildlife park settings in the world, where animals roam freely in open and naturalistic habitats. The 26-hectare wildlife park is nestled within the lush Mandai rainforest that stretches into the magnificent Upper Seletar Reservoir. More than 2,800 animals representing over 300 species of mammals, birds and reptiles call Singapore Zoo home.

Day 3 - CONTINUED

Many of the animal habitats incorporate special viewing features such as elevated platforms to view the giraffe exhibit, underwater galleries to see the watery worlds of the otters, pygmy hippos and giant estuarine crocodiles, as well as glass observatories to see animals such as the predatory cheetahs and lions. On top of the fascinating perspective of the animals, you get to view them in environments that have been thoughtfully built and landscaped after their habitats in the wild. After our visit we have an insightful visit the Kranji War Cemetery is located and is the final resting place for **Allied** soldiers who perished during the **Battle of Singapore** and the subsequent Japanese occupation of the island from 1942 to 1945 and in other parts of Southeast Asia during World War II.

We enjoy lunch at a local restaurant during our day, but don't fill up too much as we have a High Tea at Raffles Hotel to look forward to in the afternoon. Raffles Singapore is at the heart of the vibrant business and civic district, a beacon of classic colonial architecture and the hallowed birthplace of the Singapore Sling cocktail.

Dinner is by your own arrangement this evening. You may like to revisit the Singapore zoo for the Night Zoo Experience, dine atop the Super Trees or browse the many nearby eateries.



SENTOSA ISLAND

Day 4 - (B, D) - 14th May 2025

Our touring today takes us to Sentosa Island. Getting there will be an adventure itself as we take the cable car over the island giving us a bird's eye view of what we have in store for the day. Our first visit upon arrival onto the island is to S.E.A. Aquarium, the world's largest aquarium and Marine Life Park. After a morning of wonderment viewing a multitude of underwater creatures, we enjoy lunch at our own arrangement and expense. While on the Island there is the opportunity to walk along the Fort Siloso Skywalk Trail. The 1.5 km walk is divided up with shaded areas which discussed history or developments with amazing views of Fort Silso, at your own pace or sit and enjoy the views. We return to the hotel for dinner.



CULTURAL EXPLORATIONS

Day 5 - (B, L, D) - 15th May 2025

Start your day with a visit to the Singapore City Gallery, where you'll explore the city's urban transformation through interactive exhibits and detailed models. This gallery offers a comprehensive view of Singapore's planning efforts and future developments, providing a fascinating glimpse into the city's architectural evolution. Next, head to The Pinnacle@Duxton, an iconic residential development known for its skybridge that offers stunning panoramic views of the city. Take in the breathtaking skyline from this vantage point, which showcases both the modernity and greenery of Singapore.

Day 5 - CONTINUED.

For lunch, enjoy a meal at a local restaurant, savoring authentic Singaporean flavors that reflect the city's multicultural heritage. After lunch, visit the world-renowned Gardens by the Bay, a futuristic park that features the stunning Supertree Grove, Cloud Forest, and Flower Dome. Wander through these lush, innovative gardens and marvel at the blend of nature and cutting-edge technology that has made this one of Singapore's top attractions. End your day with a seafood dinner at East Coast Lagoon Food Village, a beloved destination for both locals and tourists. Enjoy fresh seafood, including Singapore's famous chili crab, while dining al fresco by the seaside. This casual yet iconic experience is the perfect way to unwind and reflect on our week in Singapore.



HOMeward BOUND

Day 6 - (B, L, IFM) - 16th May 2025

On our last day in Singapore, we check out of our hotel and make the most of the morning with a visit to Changi Chapel and Museum situated just outside the present Changi Prison. Changi Chapel and Museum tells the story of the Prisoners of War and civilians interned in Changi Prison camp during the Japanese Occupation. The museum's narrative is centered on remembrance and reflection, encouraging visitors to contemplate both the hardships that the internees underwent, as well as their courage and resilience in the face of difficulties. Lunch today is at the Bark Café followed by a Bum Boat Ride. These sturdy, low-slung vessels were once the main transport for commercial goods in Singapore and are now floating tour buses. The cruises, which wind along the Singapore River past skyscrapers, colonial landmarks, and traditional Chinese shophouses a great way to see the city one last time away from the hustle and bustle.
