

Banna Avenue is the place to be on Saturday for the Sidewalk Sale where you can shop 'til you drop. We have time to wander and pick up a bargain at the local retail stores along the sidewalk. We head out of town to visit Catania Fruit Salad Farm. This family owned business, produces a variety of fruits and nuts which we can sample on our tour.
