


TOUR OVERVIEW



CANBERRA TO MAITLAND Day 1 - Wednesday 30 April 2025 (LD)

GLEN INNES AND THE CELTIC FESTIVAL Day 3 - Friday 2 May 2025 (BLD)

Glen Innes festivities are in full swing today with the **official opening of the annual Australian Celtic Festival** taking place in the Town Square late this morning. The Australian Celtic Festival is renowned as the premier Celtic event in NSW and have the unique atmospheric benefit of being located at the national acclaimed Australian Standing Stones. We stop for a visit at the **Land of the Beardies History House**. We enjoy lunch here before heading out of town to visit **Emmaville** and the **Mining Museum**. On arrival we view the replica miners hut and blacksmiths shop and more than 200 historical photographs. We return to Glen Innes after an interesting day.
