Day 1 - Saturday 5 April 2025 (HTD)

Escape to flashy Manhattan in the 1950s: a colourful, larger than life world of showgirls and gangsters, set against the backdrop of Sydney's glittering harbour. The score is packed with huge hits including 'Luck Be a Lady', 'Sit Down You're Rockin' the Boat' and 'I've Never Been in Love Before'.
