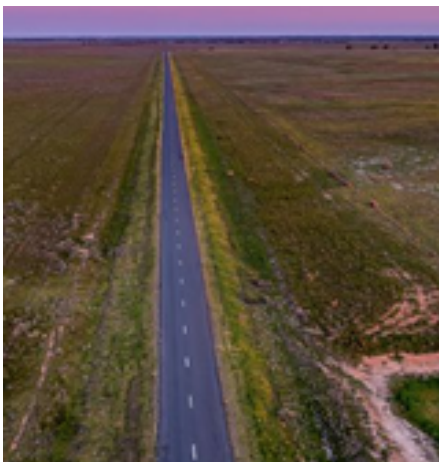


GRIFFITH CITRUS SCULPTURES

Day 2 - Tuesday 14 October 2025 (BLD)

Our touring today starts at the Visitor Centre where we watch an interesting video on the town which give us a good introduction to the area. We will also have time to wander through the interpretive displays. We are then met by our local guide for a town tour taking in the history of the Griffith area. Here we visit the Griffith Citrus Sculptures where more than 60 creative sculptures line Banna Avenue. Witness the remarkable display made from over 100,000 locally grown oranges and grapefruit.

We have lunch here before time at leisure in Griffith.



GRIFFITH TO BERRI

Day 3 - Wednesday 15 October 2025 (BLD)

Looking out the window as we cross the Hay Plain, the seemingly endless horizon gives us a true sense of how flat and vast this area is. This is one of the flattest, widest open plains in the world.

We will then stop at the Balranald Discovery Centre and Museum, where we will uncover the stories of the region's pioneering past, fascinating wildlife, and Indigenous heritage. A delicious lunch awaits. From here we continue to Berri, located on the mighty Murray River, and our home for the next three nights.

BERRI, BANROCK AND LOXTON

Day 4 - Thursday 16 October 2025 (BLD)

At the historical **Loxton Historical Village**, we feel like we've been transported back to the late 1890s. Late morning we stop at the award winning **Banrock Station** which lies at the junction of the Banrock Creek and the Murray River.

RIVERLAND ROSE & GARDEN FESTIVAL

Day 5 - Friday 17 October 2025 (BD)

The **Riverland Rose and Garden Festival** celebrates the region and its communities with an opportunity to showcase the regions produce, scenery and of course gardens. Today we'll stroll through thousands of colourful and fragrant roses at the various gardens that are open to us today. We'll also head to the **Renmark Institute Floral Display**. Next, we visit **Olivewood Homestead**, a homestead and museum containing relics from 1887 and traces of the story of the Chaffey Brothers. It also has a heritage listed olive plantation, sweeping lawns and stunning garden beds with old fashioned roses.

After a wonderful day, we return to Berri.

After lunch, we continue through to Mulwala, where we check into the Yarrowonga RSL Club and freshen up before our farewell dinner.

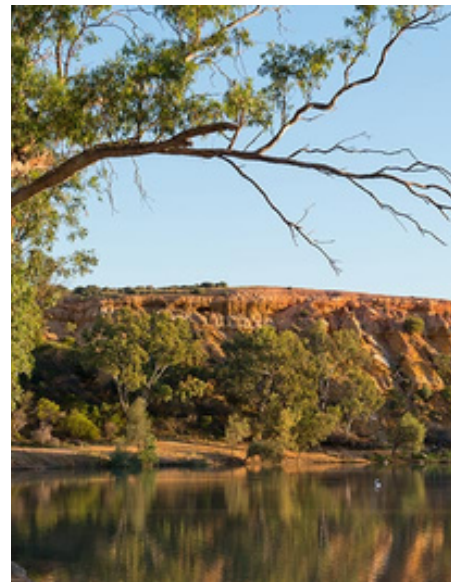
