CANBERRA TO ECHUCA

Day 1 - Saturday 13 September 2025 (LD)

We have time to visit the museum showcasing a restored Catalina and the original secret communications bunker. Further on a delicious lunch awaits us at the club in **Tooleybuc**. Day 3 - Monday 15 September 2025 (BD)

Our day starts with a visit to the delightful **Clifford's Honey Farm**, a local enterprise that holds a special place on Kangaroo Island. The farm is home to its very own population of Ligurian Bees, a pure and distinct strain. Prepare to immerse yourself in the world of honey production. We stay for **lunch** then embark on the second leg of the day's adventure. Cygnet River leads us to the picturesque Emu Bay and a lovely Lavender Farm that sprouted from the dreams of its passionate owners, Maria and Tony. Following an informative talk, treat the tastebuds to the unique experience of savouring lavender treats. Our day complete we return to our hotel.



KANGAROO ISLAND WILDLIFE

Day 5 - Wednesday 17 September 2025 (BLD)

Kangaroo Island offers a remarkable array of wildlife and today presents a special opportunity to engage with some of that incredible wildlife. Accompanied by our **local expert**, our journey begins at famous **Seal Bay**. Next on the itinerary is **Raptor Domain** where we have the privilege of witnessing a free-flight, birds of prey demonstration. Afterward we enjoy **lunch** before heading towards the island's southwestern edge.
