Day 1 - Monday 8th December 2025 (BLD)

This renowned stud is dedicated to preserving and promoting the breed, drawing on generations of livestock expertise. After an eventful day, we make our way to the Federation Motor Inn in Young for check-in and a chance to relax. This evening, enjoy a hearty dinner at the Young Services Club, conveniently located just across the road from the hotel.

YOUNG TO CANBERRA - CHERRY PICKING Day 2 - Tuesday 9th December 2025 (BL)

Today offers a delightful blend of natural beauty, local flavour, and rich history. We begin with a visit to **Poppa's Fudge and Jam Factory**, where shelves are filled with irresistible handmade treats. Enjoy time to browse and shop for locally crafted jams, fudges, and sweet delights. Next, stretch your legs with a gentle stroll through the picturesque **Lambing Flat Gardens**. This peaceful oasis showcases the tranquil charm of the **Hilltops Region**, with manicured paths, vibrant blooms, and quiet corners to reflect.

Then it's on to **Ballinaclash Cherry Orchard**, where neat rows of cherry trees blanket the landscape in seasonal splendour. Depending on the time of year, you might pick your own cherries, sample fresh fruit straight from the tree, or simply soak in the scenic views while learning about the orchard from passionate local growers. Be sure to browse the farm shop—home to cherry pies, jams, wine, and other tempting treats. After a relaxed country-style lunch, we journey to the magnificent **landra Castle**, a hidden treasure near Greenethorpe. This grand homestead, with its turreted towers and sweeping gardens, offers a rare glimpse into Australia's pastoral heritage. Wander through beautifully restored interiors, learn about the pioneering Greene family, and admire the striking fusion of Gothic Revival and Federation architecture. We return home in the late afternoon, with hearts full and memories made in the beautiful Hilltops Region.



BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Cancellation:
