Noumea, New Caledonia

Day 4 - Tuesday 28th April 2026

Today we are docked in Noumea, the capital of New Caledonia, is a delightful fusion of French culture and Pacific Island charm. Once a little-known French possession known for its penal colony and natural resources, Noumea has evolved into a popular travel destination renowned for its white-sand beaches, clear blue waters, and the world's second-longest barrier reef—making it a paradise for snorkelling and diving enthusiasts. In 1774, Captain James Cook named the island New Caledonia after noting its resemblance to the rugged hills of his native Scotland. It became a French colony in 1854 and an overseas department of France in 1956.

Suggested Shore Excursion: Tjibaou Cultural Centre Tour

Duration: 2.5 hours | Price: \$119.95 per person Activity Level: Easy
Discover the rich cultural heritage of New Caledonia with a guided tour of the Tjibaou Cultural Centre—an architectural icon designed by award-winning architect Renzo Piano. Inspired by traditional Kanak huts, the centre's striking sail-like structures are home to fascinating exhibits celebrating Kanak art, history, and spiritual beliefs. Stroll along the Kanak path, featuring native plants and mythological symbols, and explore themed gardens representing key cultural concepts such as rebirth, duality, and the unseen world. A highlight is the moving exhibit dedicated to Jean-Marie Tjibaou, whose vision brought this cultural landmark to life.

Mystery Island, Vanuatu

Day 5 - Wednesday 29th April 2026

Step ashore at Mystery Island, a tiny, uninhabited paradise in southern Vanuatu. Once used as a World War II airstrip, its hidden location earned it the name "Mystery Island." Today, it offers the charm of a secret oasis with pristine white-sand beaches, crystal-clear waters, and swaying palms. Upon arrival, enjoy live island music and browse a vibrant local market offering handicrafts, and local foods.

Suva, Fiji

Day 7 - Friday 1st May 2026

Located in the heart of the South Pacific, Fiji is a tropical paradise made up of 333 islands, offering everything from adventure to relaxation. Once known as "The Cannibal Isles," Fiji's ancient warrior past now lives on through cultural rituals like firewalking, Kava ceremonies, and traditional dance and music. Suva, the capital and cultural heart of Fiji, sits on a reef-protected natural harbour surrounded by lush rainforest. A lively mix of colonial charm and modern life, Suva is home to vibrant markets, diverse architecture, and a multicultural population reflected in its many churches, temples, mosques, and shrines.

Relax in air-conditioned comfort as you take a guided sightseeing tour through Suva, passing lush landscapes and learning about Fiji's rich and colourful history. A highlight of the tour is a visit to the headquarters of Pure Fiji, an internationally acclaimed skincare brand that blends traditional island beauty rituals with modern techniques. Meet the founder and gain insight into the use of coconut oil and native flower extracts in their luxurious products. Conclude your experience with a scenic drive through Suva's bustling city streets before returning to port.

Suggested Shore Excursion: Suva Village Cultural Experience

Duration: 3.5 hours | Price: \$84.95 per person | Activity Level: Moderate (includes snack)

Travel by bus enjoying scenic views of Suva Harbour and Lacala Bay, passing through charming suburbs and notable landmarks. Cross the Waimanu River, known for its water lilies, and visit a local village where you'll receive a warm traditional Fijian welcome. Fijian warriors in traditional attire will escort you to meet the chief and village men for a Kava ceremony. Learn about Fijian history, lifestyle, and enjoy demonstrations of traditional arts and crafts. Take a guided walk around the village, savor light refreshments, and browse unique handmade souvenirs.





Dravuni Island, Fiji

Day 8 - Saturday 2nd May 2026

Today we dock at Dravuni Island, a small and charming island in Fiji's Kadavu group. Less than two miles long, this peaceful island is home to a friendly village of around 200 residents who often welcome visitors with traditional songs. You'll find unspoiled beaches and coconut-lined trails inviting you to explore, while the crystal-clear waters offer excellent snorkelling opportunities on the Great Astrolabe Reef. For those seeking adventure, a hike to Dravuni's volcanic peak rewards you with stunning panoramic views of the surrounding islands.

Day 9 - Sunday 3rd May 2026

Enjoy a relaxing day at sea aboard the Crown Princess, where a wealth of activities and entertainment options await you. Start your morning with a refreshing swim in the pool or a workout at the state-of-the-art fitness center. Tauranga, New Zealand

Day 11 - Tuesday 5th May 2026

Today we awake to stunning views of New Zealand's Bay of Plenty, a region celebrated for its natural beauty and rich Maori heritage. Our ship docks near the foot of Mt. Maunganui, which towers 761 feet above the sparkling bay. Across the harbor lies Tauranga, a vibrant port city known for its bustling marina, scenic tidal beaches, and thriving agricultural and timber industries. This area also serves as the gateway to Rotorua, New Zealand's geothermal wonderland and cultural heartland of the Maori people, located just a 90-minute drive away. Enjoy the day exploring the region's fine beaches, thermal springs, and opportunities for big-game fishing or relaxing seaside resorts.



Day 11 - Suggested Shore Excursion: Te Pā Tū Māori Village Experience

Duration: 6 Hours | Price: \$344.95 per person

Activity Level: Easy (includes meal)

Enjoy a scenic 90-minute coach ride from the ship to the award-winning Te Pā Tū Māori Village. Upon arrival, experience a traditional Māori welcome with the powerful Haka Powhiri ceremony and explore the village nestled in a Tawa forest. Immerse yourself in ancient customs, traditional games, and native foods and medicines used by the local iwi.

Watch captivating performances of haka, song, and drama in a forest amphitheatre before enjoying a delicious buffet lunch featuring Māori fusion dishes such as hāngi lamb, baked fish, and smoked chicken. After lunch, join in the celebration with songs and stories, then return to the ship, having gained a heartfelt connection to the people, land, and history of Te Pā Tū.



Day 11 - Suggested Shore Excursion: Wai-o-Tapu Geothermal Exploration

Duration: 6 Hours | Price: \$429.95 per person

Activity Level: Moderate

Travel to Rotorua to explore Wai-o-Tapu, one of New Zealand's most remarkable geothermal parks. Accompanied by a knowledgeable local guide, discover stunning natural features shaped by volcanic activity, including the vibrant Champagne Pool, bubbling mud pools, the vividly green Devil's Bath, and the cascading Sinter Terraces.

Learn about the geological processes behind these wonders as well as the cultural significance of the area through Maori legends and scientific insights. Observe unique flora adapted to this mineral-rich environment during your guided walking tour, which also includes free time to explore independently.

Enjoy a traditional Hangi lunch prepared by a local Maori chef before returning to Tauranga.



Auckland, New Zealand

Day 12 - Wednesday 6th May 2026

Today we arrive in Auckland, New Zealand's vibrant former capital, uniquely situated on a narrow isthmus formed by 60 volcanoes. This dynamic city offers a captivating blend of scenic beauty and rich history, with landmarks such as Rangitoto Island - Auckland's largest and youngest volcano - rising majestically just offshore. Overlooking the city are Mt. Eden and One Tree Hill, both sites of ancient Māori earthworks that reflect the region's deep indigenous heritage. Auckland's cosmopolitan vibe shines through its diverse shops, restaurants, museums, galleries, and lush gardens. To the north lies one of New Zealand's premier wine regions, inviting exploration and tastings. Having served as the nation's capital from 1841 to 1865 before the government moved to Wellington, Auckland remains a bustling cultural and economic hub that beautifully blends its volcanic landscape with modern city life. 


MEDICAL DIETARY AND MOBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To ensure a safe and enjoyable cruise, all guests must be medically, physically, and mentally fit to travel, and it is your responsibility to obtain any required medical clearance. If you have a condition requiring medication, treatment, or special care, we need to inform Princess Cruises at the time of booking. A health questionnaire will be provided so appropriate arrangements or advice can be offered. Guests should bring enough medication for the entire cruise, plus a few extra days in case of delays. Please note that access to water shuttle ports may be limited for some, but plenty of onboard activities will still be available.

ONBOARD PAYMENTS

Princess Cruises operates a cashless system onboard, using the Medallion linked to your credit or debit card via the Princess® App. This Medallion is used for all onboard purchases. Alternatively, you can load funds onto it using cash. Daily pre-authorisations (not actual charges) are placed on your card to ensure sufficient funds, and a single final charge is processed at the end of the cruise for your total spend. While holds are released by Princess, some banks may take up to 30 days to return the funds, so it's important to have enough available balance. All accounts must be settled before disembarkation to avoid future booking issues or withheld refunds.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Passports with a minimum 6 months from the return travel date are required for this cruise. Your booking must include your full name including title, first name, middle name, surname and gender for each guest as it appears on your passport.

NAME CHANGES

Correcting or changing a name on your booking may incur a fee. Please be aware that one original guest from the booking must always remain on the booking or the booking will be subject to the applicable cancellation charges. Princess Cruises are unable to accept name changes, new bookings or new guests on existing bookings within 48 hours of departure

CANCELLATION FEES

Should You need to cancel your booking, You must notify us as soon as possible. Please note that at the time of publication the following cancellation fees from Princess Cruises are applicable:

61 to 74 days	50% of cruise fare
31 to 60 days	75% of cruise fare

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Onboard medical expenses are not covered under Australian Medicare . Onboard treatment is billed at private rates and if emergency evacuation is required it can cost thousands. Potter Travel requires all passengers to have taken out a travel insurance policy that covers cruise travel medical. It is also advisable to have in your policy cruise fare protection for unforeseen circumstances resulting in cancellation prior to travel, loss or damage to baggage and personal effects, illness, medical expenses, accidental injury, or emergency evacuation. Currently all ports in New Caledonia require guests to have comprehensive international travel insurance.

SHORE EXCURSIONS

Princess Cruises offers a wide range of shore excursions, available at an additional cost, designed to suit all interests and activity levels—from guided cultural tours and scenic drives to adventure activities and wildlife encounters.
