**Final payment is due by Tuesday 21 April 2026.** Online Direct Debit transactions must include your **Booking Reference** noted on your **Booking Confirmation**.

A 1.99% service fee applies to all credit/debit card transactions. This covers the cost of using Stripe's reliable payment processing services. ### Cancellation:

You may cancel your booking by giving written notice to Potter Travel or calling our reservation team. Cancellation fees and charges will be levied as follows, irrespective of when notice of cancellation is received:
