CULTURAL EXPLORATIONS

Day 3 - Thursday 11th February 2027 (B, L, D)

Today's touring in Singapore showcases the city's vibrant blend of nature, heritage and culture. We begin at the stunning **National Orchid Garden**, set within the Singapore Botanic Gardens, where thousands of orchids are displayed in beautifully landscaped surrounds. Continue to **Merlion Park** for iconic views across Marina Bay and a perfect photo opportunity with Singapore's famous symbol.



Our journey then takes us into the heart of **Chinatown**, where bustling streets, traditional shop houses and colourful temples reveal the city's rich cultural tapestry, beautifully decorated for Chinese New Year celebrations. We also visit the **Peranakan Museum**, offering a fascinating insight into the unique heritage and traditions of the Straits Chinese community.

After a full day of discovery, we return to our hotel to enjoy a relaxing buffet dinner.



SINGAPORE ZOO & RAFELLS HIGH TEA

Day 4 - Friday 12th February 2027 (B L)

This morning, we visit the **Singapore Zoo**, where you can enjoy **breakfast “in the wild”** alongside animals such as orangutans, African penguins, sea lions, and Bengal eagle owls (subject to rotation, weather, and animal conditions on the day). After breakfast, we spend the morning exploring this world-renowned wildlife attraction, celebrated since 1973 for its immersive, open-concept habitats set within the lush Mandai rainforest near Upper Seletar Reservoir. Home to more than 2,800 animals across over 300 species, the zoo features innovative viewing experiences including elevated platforms, underwater galleries, and glass observatories, offering unique perspectives of animals in thoughtfully recreated natural environments.



We enjoy lunch at a local restaurant during our day, but don't fill up too much as we have a **High Tea at Raffles Hotel** to look forward to in the afternoon. **Raffles Singapore** is at the heart of the vibrant business and civic district, a beacon of classic colonial architecture and the hallowed birthplace of the Singapore Sling cocktail.

Dinner is by your own arrangement this evening as we take in the sights of the Chinese New Year, at leisure from our centrally located hotel.



SENTOSA ISLAND & GARDENS BY THE BAY

Day 5 - Saturday 13th February 2027 (B, L)

Today we explore two of Singapore's most iconic attractions at a relaxed and enjoyable pace. We begin with **Sentosa Island**, featuring a scenic cable car journey with sweeping views over the harbour and skyline. Continue to **Fort Siloso**, where Singapore's wartime history is brought to life through preserved gun emplacements and engaging exhibits. We then visit the **Singapore Oceanarium**, a world-class, newly reimagined attraction showcasing immersive marine environments and vibrant aquatic habitats through state-of-the-art displays. Lunch is included during the touring.

In the afternoon, we return to the hotel for a well-earned rest and time to refresh before our evening experience.

Later, we head out to **Gardens by the Bay**, where guests can explore the spectacular **Flower Dome and the enchanting Cloud Forest**, home to the world's tallest indoor waterfall and lush, mist-filled landscapes. BIRD PARADISE AND SINGAPORE SIGHTSEEING

Day 6 - Sunday 14th February 2027 - Valentines Day ❤️ (B,L D)

Today we discover a blend of Singapore's modern cityscapes and world-class wildlife experiences. We begin with a visit to **Bird Paradise**, Singapore's newest avian park, where immersive walk-through aviaries showcase an extraordinary variety of birdlife from around the globe in lush, free-flying environments. We then continue to the **Pinnacle@Duxton Skybridge**, offering sweeping panoramic views over Singapore's skyline from one of the city's most striking residential landmarks. Lunch is included during the day's sightseeing.

In the evening, we enjoy a relaxed coastal dining experience at the **East Coast Seafood Centre**, renowned for its fresh local seafood and lively waterfront atmosphere, before returning to the hotel with transfers included.
